Continue to be a trusted and respected organisation, fulfilling the needs of our members and community.



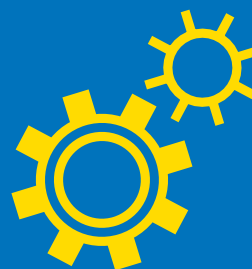
### Brand

Remain an employer of choice in youth and community development and provide a safe, inclusive environment for staff, members and community.



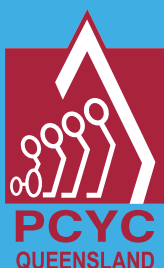
### Sustainability
