Importantly, our clubs play a vital role in the lives of over 50,000 young people each year to have positive experiences, get involved in a range of sports and activities, and benefit from great mentors and community leaders including our serving police officers. Many of the young people we support are at risk, disadvantaged or disengaged. You make the difference. Almost 90% of our work is funded through kind donations and our fee-for-services. The remaining is from various levels of government funding, including for our Indigenous programs funded on an annual basis, and significant in-kind and some monetary support from our QPS partners. Any surplus revenue goes straight back into our programs and facilities, as well as the communities in which we serve.

## Why support PCYC Queensland?

PCYC Queensland recognises our work in supporting and addressing young people who may be at risk, disadvantaged or disengaged across the state is far from over and more support is needed. With increased financial support, PCYC Queensland can be in a stronger position to continue to deliver recurring initiatives that give young people purpose, focus and motivation to make positive choices.

You can make the difference. Your regular workplace giving will enable us the flexibility to plan for our future and respond to unexpected needs.

By choosing to participate in workplace giving for PCYC Queensland, you will

- Receive an upfront tax benefit – you immediately pay less tax, rather than claiming your donations back at the end of the year
- Have confidence that your donation is maximised
- Make a real difference to young people who may be at risk, disadvantaged or disengaged.

## What is workplace giving?

Workplace giving is a government initiative that enables you to regularly donate to a registered charity with deductible gift recipient (DGR) status, such as PCYC Queensland. If your employer offers workplace giving, you can nominate PCYC Queensland and the amount to be deducted from your pre-tax income via your payroll.

## How does workplace giving work?

Your employer pays your donation directly to PCYC Queensland each payday from your pre-tax income, which does not affect the way your gross income, super guarantee payments or fringe benefits are calculated.

Details of the deduction are recorded on your pay advice, so you do not need to keep receipts for taxation purposes. Your employer will issue you a statement, along with your PAYG payment summary stating the amount donated to PCYC Queensland for the financial year at tax time. You will not need to do anything as the tax deduction will already have been received. Find out more at [ato.gov.au](http://ato.gov.au)

## How much can I contribute?

You can contribute a pre-tax donation of as little as \$2 per pay period, and there is no limit to how much you can give. Your small change can help PCYC Queensland make a big difference to young people who may be at risk, disadvantaged or disengaged.

## What is matched workplace giving?

As a further incentive to employees, employers can also match your contributions. This means employers match any contributions dollar for dollar, or even double the donations to help make an even bigger impact! The amount matched becomes a tax deduction for the employer. So, get your workplace giving too.

## How do I set up a workplace giving program as an employer?

As a workplace the giving program is easy to setup. Once your employees have agreed to the program just send their completed Employee Contribution forms to PCYC Queensland and start making a difference to young people across the state.
