

Our PCYC Queensland story

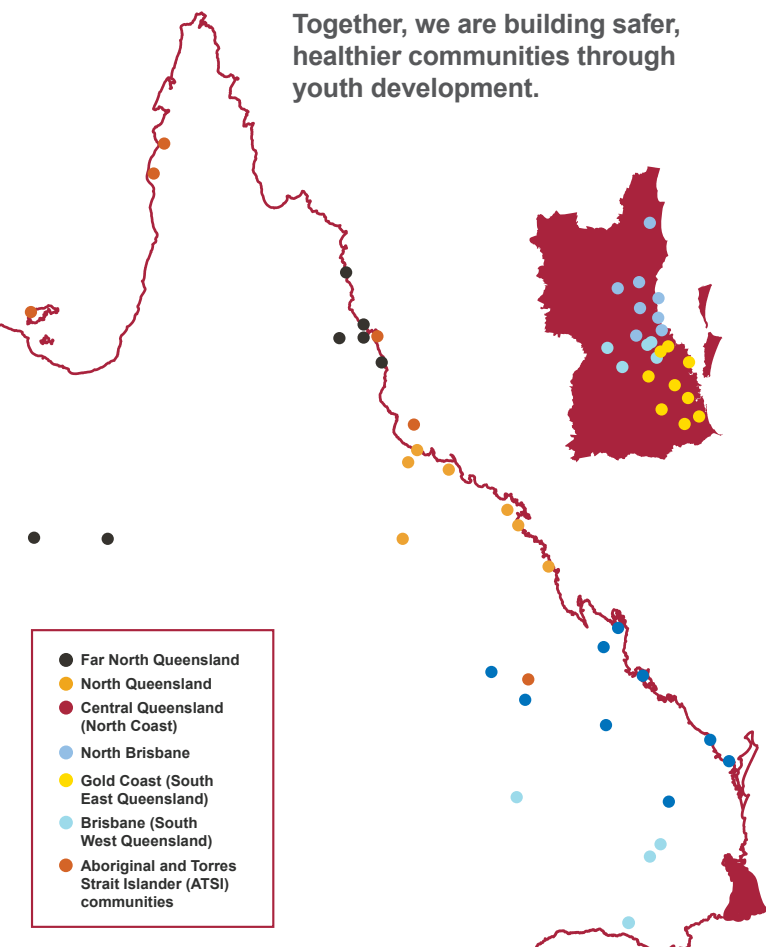
PCYC Queensland supports more than 80,000 members across 56 clubs from the Torres Strait Islands to the Gold Coast and beyond.
